



Tito's new position

THE Tourism Business Council of South Africa has elected former South African Reserve Bank Governor Tito Mboweni as the chairman of its board of directors. Mboweni will take over the reins from Mavuso Msimang who served two terms in the position.

The tourism body is a member-based organisation, made up of trade associations as well as leading corporations in the travel and tourism sector.

Mboweni was labour minister in President Nelson Mandela's cabinet from 1994 to 1998 and served as the first black governor of the South African Reserve Bank for 10 years.
