Challenge won on sunbeam power

ELEVEN teams from all over the world crossed the finish line in Cape Town on Saturday after driving just over 27 000km collectively on public roads on solar

power alone.

Dutch team Nuon won the Sasol Solar Challenge after

completing 4716km, breaking the four-year record of 4630km and beating Japanese team Tokai by

Japanese team Tokki 2, 172km.

The competition started in Pretoria.

North West University was fourth, with 3 524km

under its belt, and high school team Maragon Olym-pus beat the University of Johannesburg by only 40km to take seventh place.

The teams will build new vehicles for the 2017, shorter, challenge in Australia.
